Work to improve the A14 and M11

We are working on behalf of Highways England to improve the A14 and M11 near you. This work will help to make the road safer and improve the road surface.

Subject to weather conditions, we plan to start the following work on Monday 16 November:

- Resurfacing the road and replacing signs on Impington bridge, which will take around 9 weeks.
- Resurfacing the road and replacing damaged kerbs on the southbound exit of the M11, junction 13 (A1303 to Madingley), which should be done in 1 night.
- Refurbishment of Huntingdon bridge, which will take 4 and a half months.
- Geotechnical repairs to improve drainage and reduce the risk of flooding at A1307 Huntingdon Road, near Grange Farm, and at junction 33 (A1309 at Chesterton) – ongoing until early next year (please note we expect minimal disruption).

Starting on Wednesday 18 November we will also be:

- Resurfacing the road and replacing road markings on the A14 between junctions 29 (Lolworth) and 31 (M11), which will just over 3 weeks.
- Putting up new signs for Addenbrooke's Hospital by junction 11 (Trumpington) of the M11, which will take around 1 week.

We will be working between 21:00 and 06:00, with the M11 work between 22:00 and 05:00. We apologise for any delays this creates for your staff and customers.

To keep road users at a safe distance from the works, we will need to close the roads to traffic during the night. There will be some daytime lane closures with 40mph speed limits in place. We will put a clearly signposted diversion route in place and you should leave extra time for your journey.

We will do our utmost to complete the works as quickly as possible, avoiding disturbance and keeping noise to a minimum. Once complete, the work will result in a smoother and safer A14, better bridges, and clearer directions to Addenbrooke's Hospital. There will also be numerous environmental benefits such as a reduced risk of flooding.

Work	How the road is affected	Diversion
Resurfacing the road and replacing signs on Impington bridge	The A14 will be closed between 9pm and 6am on weeknights (in one direction – eastbound and westbound works will not be done simultaneously)	<u>Eastbound</u> - Motorway Traffic: exit at J32 and return westbound on the A14 to J31 then on to the M11 south to J10 and exit on to the A505 heading east to the A11, then north on the A11 to the A14. - Non Motorway Traffic: leave at J32 and then head south on the B1049 Cambridge Road turning left on to Kings hedges Road then travelling east to the A10 Milton Road where you will turn left on heading north to the A14 J33 where the diversion ends. - Alternative Non Motorway Traffic: exit at J32 and return west on the A14 to the A428 to the Dry Drayton interchange returning east on the A428 to the A1303 exit. Heading east on the A1303 Huntingdon Road and then Madingley Road on to Northampton Street, Chesterton Lane and Chesterton Road, Milton Road (A1134) then Milton Road (A1309) to A14 J33. <u>Westbound</u> - The westbound carriageway will be closed from J36. - Motorway Traffic: head south on the A11 to the A505 where you will head west to the M11 J10 and then head north on the M11 to J14 where the diversion ends. - Non Motorway Traffic: follow the same diversion until you reach the M11 J10 where you shall continue west on the A505 to the A10 and then head north on the A10 to the A14 where the diversion ends.
Resurfacing the road and replacing damaged kerbs on the southbound exit of the M11, junction 13 (A1303 to Madingley)	The slip road will be closed between 9pm and 6am for 1 night.	You will be diverted via the A1303 Madingley Road to the A1134 Queens Road travelling south to the A603 Barton Road heading west where you will rejoin the M11 at J12
Refurbishment of Huntingdon bridge	The A1307 will be closed overnight between 9pm and 6am. Daytime 24 hour lane closures with 40mph speed restriction.	<u>Eastbound</u> - You will be diverted via the A14 J31 to J32 then south on the B1049 to Huntingdon Road then west on Huntingdon Road, where the diversion ends <u>Westbound</u> - You will be diverted south east on the A1307 Huntingdon Road to the B1049 where it will travel north to J32, then west on the A14 to the A428 exiting on to the A14 Westbound where the diversion ends.
Geotechnical repairs to improve drainage and reduce the risk of flooding at A1307 Huntingdon Road, near	There will be a mixture of overnight road closures and/or a lane being closed between 8pm and 6am.	- During full closures eastbound traffic will be diverted off the A14 at J28 and return west on the A14 to J24, then head south on the A1089 to the A428 where you will head east on the A428 then on to the A14 where the diversion ends. - Traffic travelling east on the A14 and then on to the M11 south will follow the same

Grange Farm		diversion to the A14 but will then continue on to J32 at Histon where you will leave the A14 and return west on the A14 exiting at J31 for the M11 south where the diversion ends.
Geotechnical repairs to improve drainage and reduce the risk of flooding at at junction 33 (A1309 at Chesterton)	The road will be closed overnight. One lane will be closed at all other times with a 40mph speed limit in place.	You will be diverted south east on the A1307 Huntingdon Road to the B1049 where it will travel north to J32 of the A14, then west on the A14 to the A428 exiting on to the A14 Westbound where the diversion ends.
Resurfacing the road and replacing road markings on the A14 between junctions 29 (Lolworth) and 31 (M11)	The road will be closed eastbound overnight between 9pm and 6am from J28 to J31.	- Eastbound traffic will be returned westbound to Spittals Interchange then south on the A1 then A428. - All traffic for A14 eastbound junctions between 26 and 29 will continue eastbound to J32 and return westbound on the A14 to Girton, taking the exit for junctions 29 to 26.
Putting up new signs for Addenbrooke's Hospital by junction 11 (Trumpington) of the M11	One lane and the hard shoulder will be closed overnight in both directions approaching J11. There may be a speed limit in place.	N/A.
